Translation of a letter
of instructions by the
Regard to his followers

17
Arrangements for a general attack on
British Troops throughout the protect-
ed Country / Oudh / on 22nd Suffer
1275 Hijree, corresponding with 1st October
1858.

* This I suppose
is the title of Khan
Ali Khan.

Intizam-ood-dowlah is requested to con-
-centrate a sufficient force, including
Artillery for the defence of Pilibhet, on
the Pheera and Jugdaadpore Roads. The
leaders to be Enayet Ali Khan, Wazir
Ali Khan late Sub Assistant Surgeon,
and others.

Intizam-ood-dowlah also requested to form
a force for the taking of Shahjhanpore
and Pwayew under the command of
General Ismael Khan and Mohsum
Ali Khan.

Intizam-ood-dowlah will, with the re-
-maining troops and guns at his disposal,
and the assistance of Talooqdars and
Zameendars, guard the Lookatha Nullah,
and when required reinforce the Troops
at Pilibhet and Shahjhanpore and
look to the provision of supplies for
them.

Mohomed Soorabaz Khan, Collector,
and Mohomedood Dowlah Bahadour,
to proceed with Troops under their com-
-mand to the boundary of Pilibhet,
between the Deeah and to form an en-
-trenchment at Billa Putwara.

Enayet Khan, Amil of Landee, Shaulie
Fuzul Hugg

Fuzul Hugg and Sheer Kashef Ali
to be posted at Shahabad, to interrupt the
Communication between Shaharpoor
and Futtehghurh. Mahomed Kulle Beg
Khan, Amil of Raunur to stop the crossing
of British Troops over the Ganges from
Koswarah Ghat, to Nawanou Ghat.
Rajah Surpurnah Bahadur to sta-
-tion his force at Mohorah Sewchubee
in the Raunee Clang, for the collection
of the Shahabad Revenue, and to check
the advance of British Troops from Bute-
-shee to Tulas and Shundeas.

Mahomed Imadooldeen Khan Baha-
-door, Rajah Goolab Sing Bahadour,
Raja Kirput Sing Bahadour, and
Kaudar Khan Bahadour, to form
4 Detachments under their respective
Command, two to be detached to Sur-
-deela, and the other two in the direc-
-tion of Shuleebad and Ruheemabad
Valait Ahmed, Amil at Suffespoor,
and Chandhree, Amil of Pupsoolabad,
with the assistance of Talooquads and
and Zameendars to form 2 parties, one
to march towards Pupsoolabad and
the other to Coran.

Rana Rance Shads British, Selare
jung, and Mahomed Fuzul Azem
Khan

Khaw Bahadour, with the aid of Na-
-loogdars and Troops at their disposal,
both Foot and Artillery, to protect the
borders of Oudh at the boundaries of
Allahabad, Aoran, and Secundra send-
-ing half their force to reinforce the
Nizam of Soottaupore.

Rues Nath Singh, Talooqdar of Khejoor
goun, Rajah Deendial Singh Talooq-
-dar of Kores Sindowlee, Rajah Sing
-Bija Singh Talooqdar of Moorar now,
Juggernath Singh Talooqdar of Sonree,
the wife of Bussunt Singh Talooqdar of
Sivarepaha, and Rugher Singh Collector,
with half their force to watch the ghats
of the Ganges within the district of
Caumpore and prevent the crossing of
British Troops, and with the remaining
half meet British troops at Bunnec
Bunthura and Lucknow.

Mohomed Sooltan Asser Chute-
-ladar of Hyder Gurb, and the Ta-
-loogdars and Zameendars of Hyder
Gurb, also Hedayet Ali, Amir of
Goorsuhai Jung ^{Gen} to concentrate
their forces and attack Lucknow
from the direction of Mohomed
Ragh.

Syed Shahdee Husein Khaw Ru-
-hadour, Rajah Ali Butsh Khaw
Bahadour,

Bahadour, Talooqdar of Rahona, and
Raja Shacho Singh Bahadour, Sha-
hormud Hupun Khan Bahadour,
Talooqdar of Bijow Gurh, Goolab Singh
Talooqdar of Narwal, Rajah Houssein
ali Khan, Pansurroop Tal: of Thera
Desah ^{you}, to attack the Troops at
Sooltaupoor, and to hold the district
from Pertab Gurh and Sauda.

Shookur-ood Dowlah Bahadour,
and Rajah Dabee Puteh Singh
Bahadour, Lion in war, to attack
Fyzabad, & Amroodha, and prevent the
passage of Troops within their respective
boundaries.

Rajim Houssein Khan, with the
men he has collected, and the assistance
of Talooqdars of Hauranj and others,
will protect the Ghats of the Ghagra
with one fourth their men, $\frac{1}{2}$ the entire
force to crop and attack Durriabad.
Mahomed Dava Khan, Shantia
salar / Chief of War / with his Troops,
including Artillery, and Isaac Ali
Khan General, and Goolam Abbas
Khan, Chuchladar of Durriabad
to attack Durriabad.
Noorahil Ali Khan Bahadour, and
Wheer

Ukber Ali with their respective Troops including Artillery, to attack the British at Nawabgunj, from the direction of Lutich and Jullia para. Rajah Durgbejai Singh Tal. of Shahonah, Gholam Hosein Khan, Commanding Meerse Regiment Saif Joz, Sooral Ali Tahseeldar, to station their Troops at Shahonah near Buke-shie ki Tulas, and to hold the position, for the purpose of interrupting the line of Communication.

Mahomed Yusuf Ali Khan, Sepah Salaw, General Mahomed Saucid Khan, Rhoda Bus Khan Bahadur, Rajah Goor bus Singh, Goolam Rupoal Kariindah of Ameer-oo-dowlah, Ameer Kupon Khan Bahadur, Mahomed Ali Khan Bahadur, Collector, Mahomed Abdool Wake Collector, Recruit Singh Talogdar of Shahonah, to concentrate their forces and attack Nawabgunj Para Buntree.

Taloo-dars of Gungwal Peear-poor, Ootrawla, and Dhintea to concentrate their forces on a date prior to the (22nd Suffer 12/5) appointed date

date, join the Troops under Rajah
Dabee Rana Singh, and intimate
them having done so.
