From Camp Chauance Upouree, 25th Decr

From Commander-in-Chief

To Calcutta

To Governor General

Copy of the message from Sir James Outram to the Commander-in-Chief dated Alumb Bugh 22nd December. "Attacked a party of the enemy this morning dispersed them, capturing four guns three nine-pounders Horse Artillery complete with Limbers ammunition etc. and one six pounder, and several Waggon of ammunition and one Elephant, our loss very trifling."
