Post: Sir,

In continuation of my semi official
letter dated the 11th instant I have the honor
to inform you of the death here on the 7th
instant of Huzoor Mahal Begum of
Orisk. The Begum had been confined to her
bed for a week previously with fever and
diarrhea and at the same time her son
Brijp Nud was similarly indisposed. He
however recovered and is still in Kathmandu

The Begum has been buried in a separate ground which the Prime Minister gave for the purpose, after learning that the Mussulmans of Nepal, who are Sunnis, would not allow her body to rest in their graveyard, as she was a Shiah.

3. The Begum's allowance of Mohri Rs 400 a month has, I hear, been continued to Brijp Kuda by the Disbar.
