Sir,

It has been intimated to the Governor General that Her Majesty's Steamship Medea would be ordered to proceed to Bombay and would be there placed at His Lordship's disposal.

In order to prevent the delay which must be caused by a reference to the Governor General for instructions. I am directed by the Governor General to request you, in the event of your arriving at Bombay, with such orders from the Lords Commanders of the Admiralty as are above described, to complete as speedily as possible your preparations for the return of H.M. Steamship Medea to England.

You are requested to receive on board Lieut. Colonel Mackesow C. B. and Captain Ramsay, Military Secretary to the Governor General, who have been ordered to proceed to England on the part of the Government of India, and who have received their instructions.
