We have this day received from the Governor General
of India the Jew called the Koh-i-noor to be by us
conveyed to England in pursuance of instructions fur-
-nished to us.

The jewel was in our presence deposited in
a small iron safe, the key of which was delivered
to Lieut. Colonel Mackeson and which was
enclosed and sealed with the Governor General's
seal. The iron box was placed in a despatch
box the key of which was delivered to Captain
Ramsay and which was also enclosed and sealed
with the Governor General's seal.

The despatch box was thereafter deposited
in our presence in the Treasury at Bombay
for safe custody until the arrival of H. H.
Ship Medea.
